Show your support for Madison Parks with your name on a fence picket. The engraved pickets have a limit of 17 characters including spaces. Discounts offered if ordering multiple pickets.



Swimming Pool Chair

(Note: these benches are not secured so that mowing at the park is possible. MPF is not responsible for any benches that are removed from the park.)

These park benches made of recycled wood are the most common and are placed throughout our Madison parks.

Donations for the items listed shall only be accepted with the full understanding and agreement of the donor that the Madison Parks Division may dispose of any donated item when it reaches the end of its useful life as determined by the Madison Parks Division. Typically a new bench, fence picket or picnic table has a life expectancy of at least 10 years. After that time, if they need to be replaced, the Madison Parks Foundation will contact you at your last known address and provide the opportunity to renew your gift. The Madison Parks Foundation is not responsible for theft, vandalism or other damage that may occur to a bench, picnic table, chair, or fence picket. The City of Madison Parks staff will make every effort to properly maintain these items to department standards, contingent upon funding.
